## **Technoforum 2015**

## International Specialized Exhibition for Equipment and Technology for Processing of Construction Materials

From October 19 to 22 Pavilion No.1 of Expocentre Fairgrounds will host International Specialized Exhibition for Equipment and Technology for Processing of Construction Materials **Technoforum 2015**.

The project is carried out by Expocentre and Stankoinstrument Russian Association of Machine-Tool Manufacturers. The industry experts will be offered high-performance cutting and auxiliary instruments for machine tool systems; testing technology and metrology; diagnostic systems and test benches; energy saving technological systems and equipment for materials processing, and many others.

About 100 companies from *Belarus*, *Germany*, *Russia*, *Spain*, *Taiwan*, *Ukraine*, and the USA will showcase their products at Technoforum 2015.

Exhibitors of the Belarusian national pavilion will put on display new developments of the largest Belarusian companies, among them MZOR, Machine-Tool Plant "Krasny Borets", Baranovichi Plant of Machine Appliances, StankoGomel, Vizas Works, and others. The Belarusian national pavilion is organized by Institute Belorgstankinprom.

Among foreign participants there are HIWIN Technologies Co. (Taiwan); Knuth (Germany), ZCC (Germany); Haas (USA), Bost (Spain), and others.
